The NIHR Applied Research Collaboration Greater Manchester (ARC-GM) has an opportunity for two Research Assistant Internships to support our Dementia Research Fellows starting in **March 2025**

The DEM-COMM programme is funded by the National Institute of Health and Care Research and the Alzheimer's Society. It aims to develop leadership in dementia research by supporting community-focused projects. This programme currently supports four Research Fellows who each lead research projects in high-priority areas. - A graduate employed by an organisation providing health or social care services in Greater Manchester, or one of the Greater Manchester Higher Education Institutions.
- Able to commit to part-time working for 6–12 months.

Interns will have access to tailored training opportunities, including:

- Research methods (e.g. qualitative)
- Data analysis, including use of NVivo
- General data analysis skills
- Good Clinical Practice
